

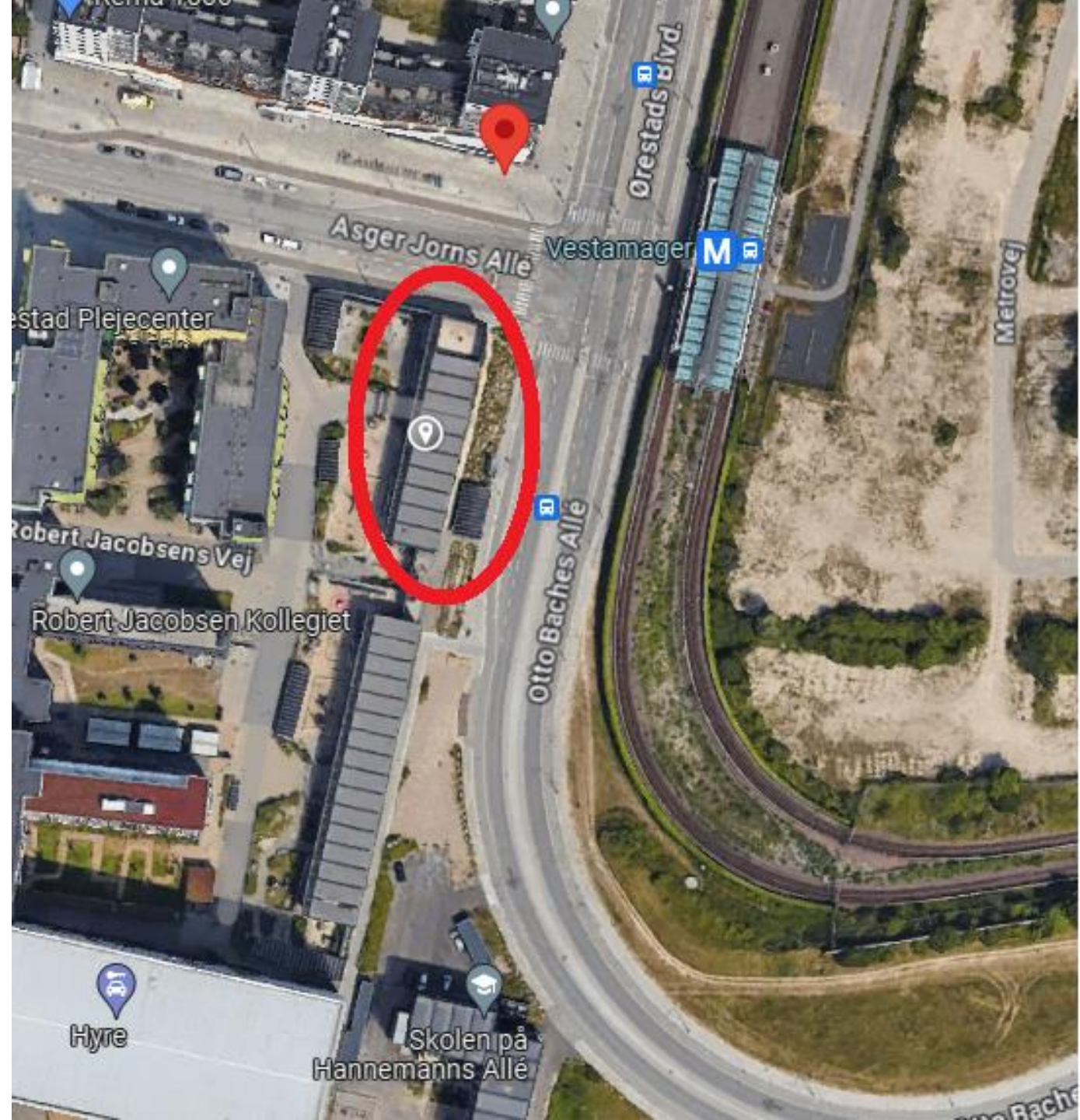

Spring course 2024

- 1st day in KKFO is 2 May at 9-11
- Approx. 100 children
- We work from a vintage perspective
- 2 floor teams with approx. 50 children per floor
- 4 adults around each floor work closely with the children
- Open groups and communities on the floor provide the best opportunities for relationship building



To start as a *May* child

- May course is to support and practice:
 - Going to KKFO
 - Making new friends
 - Get to know the new framework and structures
 - Getting a good start at school
 - Day programs and week-themes based on the six areas of competence



Being a parent of a school starter

- Parents' trust and security can be seen in the child
- Tell your child that he is always learning - things take time
- Support that you believe that the child can do all the new things
- When something is difficult, you have to use the adults (even if you don't know them yet)
- Short days at the start - if possible





En dag i majforløbet

- 6.15-7.15: Possibility of handing in tomorrow KKFO at 218 with the rest of the KKFO children
- 7.15-8: Option for morning KKFO at 200.
- 8.00-9.00: Drop off children in the group rooms. The children must arrive no later than 9 am.
- 9.00-9.15: Gathering in group room with pictograms for the day. Sing a song - rhyme or line from bridge building material - Ørestadskanon.
- 9.15-10.00: 10 am food and dialogic reading. Focus on language. 10` food/fruit is eaten and there is a break
- 10.00-11.30: Educational activities - Motor and social games.
- 11.30-12.30: Lunch and recess
- 12.30-1.30pm: Educational activities on the floor. Afternoon activities are presented in the transition to KKFO
- .30-16.00: KKFO – Recreational educational activities.
- 16.00-17.00: end in the KKFO heart room in 218 with the rest of the KKFO Pick-up possible between 1.30pm-5pm and 4pm on Friday. Remember to check out!

Overleveringsproces

- We accept children from approx. 30 kindergartens and has a close collaboration with the kindergartens in Ørestad
- We receive handovers digitally and have special handovers if necessary.
- Meetings with the kindergartens we receive many children from with a view to group dynamics



The vintage idea

- The children are divided into open classes and teams rather than fixed classes to ensure the children's well-being and good children's communities
- The children meet in the same room every day to create security



Multicultural school

- We have children from many cultures and speak about 45 different languages
- Basic Danish and Danish as a second language teaching as needed
- Mother tongue week



1. School day

1. School day for the kindergarten classes is Monday 12 August at 9.00 - 11.00

- From 13 August the children meet at 8.00 - 13.30 at school every day and then goes to KKFOen
- Each 0th grade is assigned a nursery school leader and a primary pedagogue, but the children often work in teams and will meet all kindergarten class leaders. In addition, the children can also be taught by teachers from other classes, for example in mathematics or in music.
- In the kindergarten class, the foundations are laid for the child's school life and there are MANY things to be learned during the first year.



Cooperation and communication



- We would like to take the time to speak with you. If there are important things to talk about, we make an agreement about a meeting so that the conversation does not take place over the children's heads. Mutual communication for the best interests of the childAula: weekly plans are sent out every Friday, messages and announcements

- The first day is *May 2* from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m

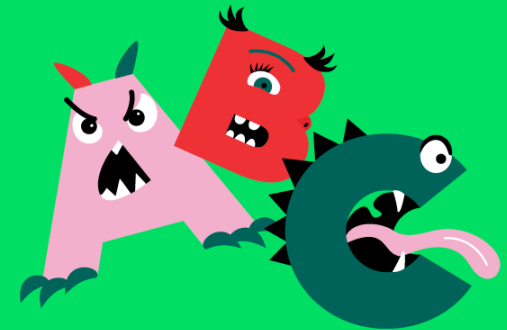
